



Daracon Croft Racing aiming to end season on a high

Daracon Croft Racing is committing all its resources towards a strong end of season showing in Round 10 of the East Coast Late Model Series at Tyrepower Parramatta City Raceway (NSW) Saturday April 19.

The North West NSW based Dirt Late Model Team has struggled to achieve any decent results in the second half of the 2007/08 season following a number of annoying car problems and on track incidents.

“It would be great to get back up front to end the season on a positive note” said team driver Ken Croft. “We started the season a bit late, meaning it was always going to be difficult to defend the East Coast Late Model Series crown we won in 2006/07, but we really didn’t expect to encounter all the problems we have”.

“The team has worked hard to ensure we always go to the start line with a competitive package, but speedway being speedway, you never know when the unexpected will be thrown up to challenge you” Croft said.

“Take our last outing at Tyrepower Parramatta City Raceway on April 5 as an example. Following our failure to go the distance in the NSW Title at Gunnedah in mid March we rebuilt the power steering, only for the same problem to resurface in Heat 1. After crossing the line in 4th we finally got on top of the power steering issue, only to go out in Heat 2 and have the transmission lock in low gear on the formation lap. There was little I could do but head back into the pits where I was forced to park the car for the night”.

“We can’t seem to take a trick at the moment, and although I’m confident that we have a good car setup, it’s pretty frustrating when these niggling issues keep arising”.

“Like I say, the team has been working overtime to achieve some worthwhile results, and hopefully those will come this Saturday night. We just need lady luck to come along for the ride with us!” Croft concluded.

The Daracon Croft Racing Team's best Feature finish thus far in 2007/08 has been a 3rd place at Tyrepower Parramatta City Raceway in November.
