“It just goes to show that the competition level is so high these days you can’t afford to back off even a little. Full credit to Bruce though, it was a heady drive and a great result for him aboard his new car. Rest assured though, I won’t be taking it ‘easy’ behind the wheel again, even if the lesson was learnt the hard way” stated a philosophical Croft.

“Still, second was a good solid result, and I know there is plenty more in the car yet. It’s great to be getting back on the podium on a regular basis after all our troubles at the end of last season” concluded Croft.
